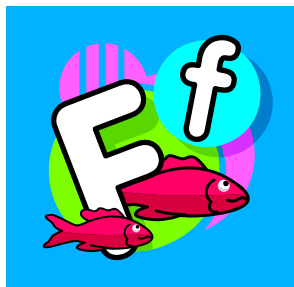


# Learning Lighthouse Preschool Newsletter
